PE uniform expectations - shorts

Behaviour & Rewards

Summer rewards trips have been announced and <u>all</u> students have been invited. Please make sure that your child strives towards the following criteria:

- 1. Excellent attendance (95%+) from Tuesday 16th April to Thursday 18th July 2024 (no more than 3 days absent)
- 2. Excellent conduct from Tuesday 16th April to Thursday 18th July 2024
- 3. Excellent punctuality to school from Tuesday 16th April to Thursday 18th July 2024
- Failure to meet this criteria will result in your child being prevented from attending.
- Students that have not booked a place by Friday 10th May will not be able to attend
- Once a trip place has been booked we cannot change/swap their trip
